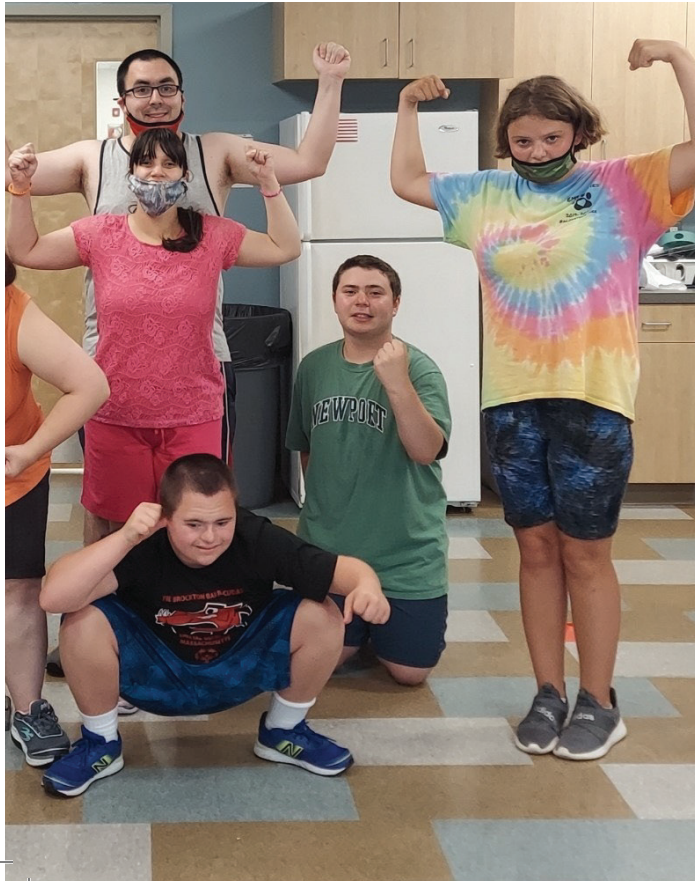

The Community Based Day Supports program provides a variety of community and center-based experiences to develop and enhance skills in personal, social, job and independent living areas based on a person's preferences and needs.

**Center Based Activities Include:**

- Career Exploration and Planning

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**Employment Services**

We operate a comprehensive Employment Services Program for participants, offering placement assistance in local businesses and within our own internal business operations. (Redemption Center and Lawn Care Services)

Our dedicated staff assist adults with varying abilities to prepare for, achieve and maintain gainful employment in the community.

**Individualized Services Encompass:**

- Assessment of skill sets and interests
- Training and skill building exercises and resources
- Job Matching to maximize the employment experience
- Job Coaching to build confidence and comfort
- Transportation coordination

Our goal is to help participants secure a quality employment experience that effectively meets their personal interests and ability, and creates a successful experience for all involved.



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**Family Support Center**

The Family Support Center provides a variety of services through the assistance of our team members, whether it is at your home, child's school, our offices, or another convenient location for you.

- Information and referral services, support meetings and educational trainings for parents, caregivers and professionals.
- Recreation and social programs for children and adults, as well as weekend programs specifically for children to provide parents a little respite.
- An Essentials Room provides free food staples and household essentials to individuals and families
- Service Navigation in such areas as:
  - ❑ Individual Family Supports, Agency with Choice, and Autism Spectrum Disorder services for adults and their families.
  - ❑ Intensive Flexible Family Supports for families experiencing significant challenges and/or with more than one individual with a disability.
  - ❑ In-home services and wrap-around supports for school-age participants.



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**Day Habilitation**

Participants in our Day Habilitation program benefit from a variety of therapeutic activities that help them reach their personal goals. All participants receive a physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech evaluation prior to developing a goal orientated plan to help them reach their personal needs and objectives
