The Arc of Greater Brockton (AGB) is an independent non-profit 501 (c) (3) organization that works in partnership with, and for, the community to provide advocacy, information, and direct services for children and adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities, and autism spectrum disorders. Our services provide choice and empowerment while supporting individuals as they strive to realize their personal goals.

A diversity of services and resources are provided through our Day Habilitation Center, Community Based Day Supports program, Family Support Center, and Employment Services. The AGB also provides employment opportunities for participants through our Bottle/Can Redemption Center, Lawn Care Company, and IdentoGo Fingerprinting service.

The AGB supports over 500 individuals and families in the region in collaboration with the State Department of Developmental Services, MassHealth, Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Mass Commission for the Blind, Mass Rehabilitation Commission, and many other state, federal and local public, private and non-profit partners

Our 11-Community Service Delivery Area

A dedicated and professional staff provides services and resources within the following 11 communities: Abington, Avon, Bridgewater, Brockton, East Bridgewater, Easton, Holbrook, Rockland, Stoughton, West Bridgewater, and Whitman.

Investing in the Present and Building for the Future

In 2021-2022 the organization invested over \$350,000 to improve the exterior presence of its Brockton facility through the construction of a new parking, circulation, drainage, signage and landscaping plan. In addition, over \$200,000 was invested to enhance the interior spaces through new room configurations, new program space and office space furnishings, and a variety of equipment upgrades.

In 2023 the Day Hab Rehabilitation Center as part of the Brockton facility is experiencing a \$400,000 renovation to expand the Medical Resource Area, Replace the Bathrooms, and add new Program and Administrative Space. A new Customer Service Area for the Redemption Center and a new Overhead Canopy over the Main Entrance will also be completed over the Summer.

In September 2023 the organization is scheduled to open a second location in Easton to provide Day Hab services for individuals with medical complexities, as well as additional day, evening and weekend programming opportunities.

Our growth will continue into 2024 as the organization actively looks to open a third location in the Abington/Rockland area, as well as implement creative expansion opportunities at its Brockton facility.
